EPA Proposes Guidelines for Electronic Reporting

EPA is proposing electronic reporting as an option for fulfilling reporting or record-keeping requirements. The proposal, published in the Federal Register on August 31, sets forth the conditions under which EPA will allow an electronic record to satisfy federal environmental recordkeeping requirements. The proposed rule could affect all agency environmental compliance reporting, including delegated state programs. The public comment period extends through November 29, 2001, and public hearings will be held in Chicago and Wash D.C.
