The attached listing provides up-to-date information regarding the epidemiological moratorium on Department of Energy (DOE) records. This information is intended to assist DOE sites and the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) in identifying those disposition authorities that continue to remain under the moratorium.

This issuance is an update to the previous listing of epidemiological records provided to you on November 22, 2000, in numbered memorandum 01-07. Please check the new listing, as there have been changes since the last transmittal.

Like the previous listing, this one also contains schedules that are obsolete. They are included because your site will have retired records using those schedules and NARA does not automatically crosswalk retired records to new schedules.
