Confidentiality will be observed outside of the assessment process. Only composite results are reported.

- Code Team Assessment Report will not attribute any information to any individual.
- Laboratory Assessment Report will not attribute any information to any individual or code team.
- Tri-Lab Survey Report will not attribute any information to any individual, code team, or laboratory source.

Every delivered report has only one recipient with the authority to make and distribute copies of the report. All reports will be marked with appropriate disclosure and distribution labels.
